



Sureclean Environmental Policy Statement

Our objective is to maintain our reputation as a major provider of shot-blasting / spray-painting, asbestos survey and removal, marine and industrial cleaning and waste treatment and disposal services.

Sureclean shall manage its activities to minimise wherever practicable, their effect on the Environment complying with the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001:2004.

Sureclean recognise that this shall only be achieved through monitoring / review and control of all activities in line with current legislation and applicable national standards.

The Company Directors shall on reviewing the operation of the Sureclean Environmental Management System use the information gathered to set objectives and targets for improvements to company operational methodologies so as to reduce or eliminate the potential for environmental effects.

The experience and qualification of the company's directors and staff shall be used to ensure that adequate training is provided to employees at all levels within the company.

These objectives and targets shall be part of the companies HSEQ plan and reviewed on a Monthly Basis.

The implications of customer requests shall be evaluated to ensure that the Environmental Protection Act 1990, the Special Waste Regulations 1996 (as amended) Legislation and the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006 is not breached. If necessary the relevant Authority, (Scottish Environmental Protection Agency or equivalent) and/or the HSE shall be contacted for guidance. Sureclean shall ensure that all its activities comply with the provisions of all legal requirements in respect of Health & Safety, Environmental, Commercial, and all other legislation relating to the operation to be carried out.

Plant, equipment and vehicles shall be maintained to reduce the risk of adverse environmental effects under normal, abnormal and emergency conditions.

Work practices and equipment shall be subject to a programme of continuous evaluation to provide improvements in operations and additional safeguards to protect the environment.

Documented procedures shall be used to set working standards and provide a means for auditing the standards of quality, safety and environmental controls.
